Extension of PtF Transition Period

Dear Partners,

We would like to inform you that in a meeting with participation of European Aviation Safety Agency (EASA) and Flight Design on March 8th 2016 in Cologne EASA agreed to extend the transition period for CTLS aircrafts under Permit to Fly (PtF) until April 30th 2018 from the present transition deadline August 20th 2016.

On April 08th 2016, Flight Design received the formal agreement document from EASA. This document provides the basis for Flight Design to continue the support for existing aircraft under PtF and to supply related services in connection with the transition to R-TC. .

The Flight Design Office of Airworthiness has started the process to prepare all required documents for Flight Design CTLS aircraft under Permit to Fly to apply at EASA for the acceptance of the granted extension.

We expect the process of documentation approval will be completed until the end of June 2016.

Flight Design will inform every customer and relevant dealer immediately about authority approval of documentation for the individual CTLS aircraft under PtF.
